## Meet legal training requirements

Does your workplace meet all mandatory health and safety training programs *and* standards? The following are just some of many important legal training obligations:

- **JHSC Certification.** Revised and more extensive Certification Program Standards for Joint Health and Safety Committees, including a minimum number of hazards to be covered in Part II Certification training, took effect March 1, 2016.
- **Working at Heights.** October 1, 2017 is the final deadline for universal compliance with working at heights training standards in the construction sector, although for those yet untrained in a Ministry of Labour-approved program proof of registration is required immediately.
- **WHMIS-GHS.** As of June 1, 2015, employers must also train or retrain workers and supervisors to comply with the changes to WHMIS regulations prompted by Canada's adoption of the Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals (GHS).

### Employers must provide training related to:

- Safe Lockout
- Worker Awareness
- Confined Space Entry
- Supervisor Competency
- Mobile Equipment Operator Competency
- Transportation of Dangerous Goods
- Workplace Violence and Harassment.

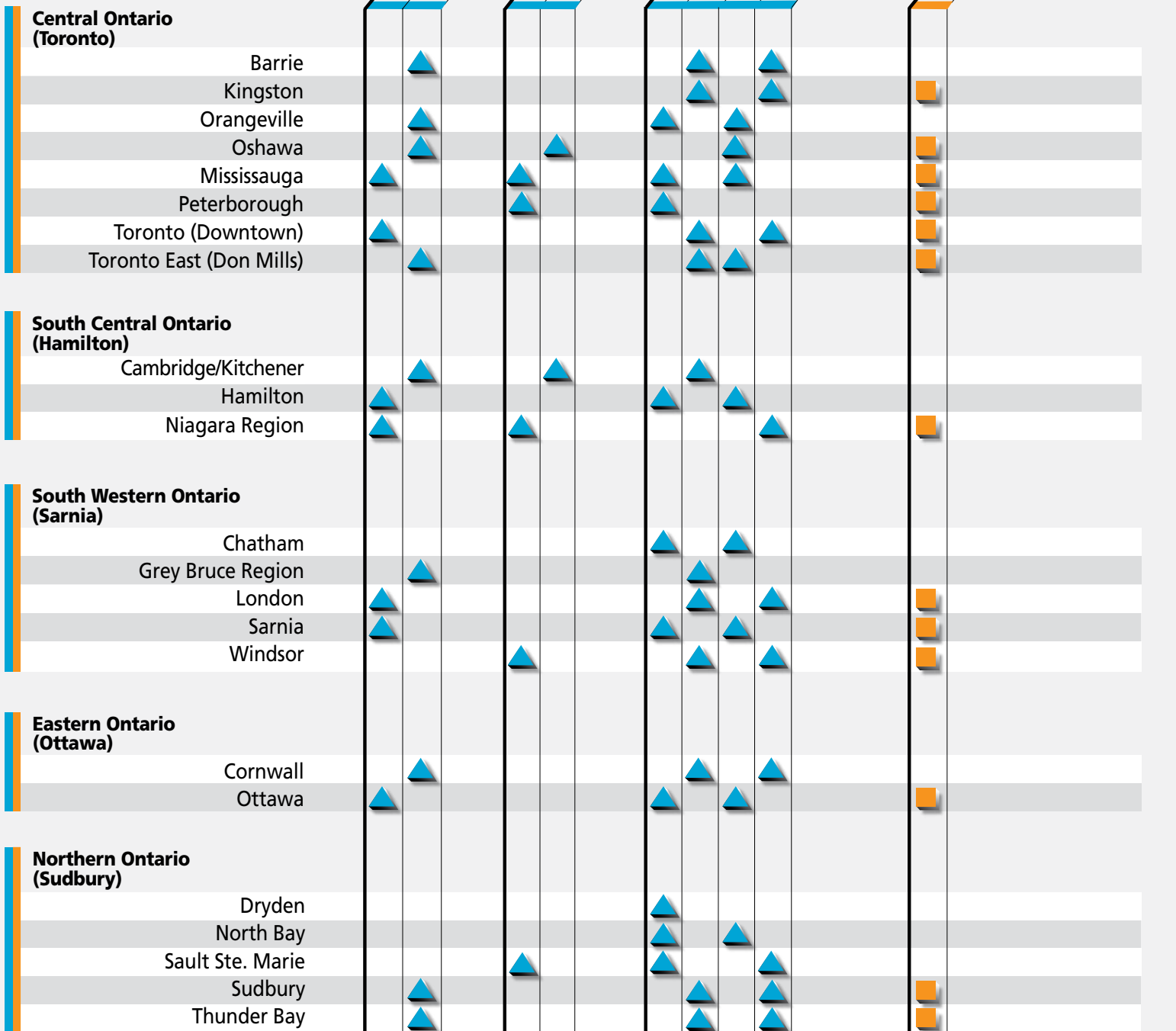
