Workers Health & Safety Centre (WHSC) believes training plays a central role in workplace prevention efforts. Health and safety law recognizes its value too. Ontario employers, for instance, have a legal duty to provide information, instruction and supervision to workers to protect their health and safety. Beyond this general duty, employers must also meet many specific training obligations. These requirements include the following.

Working at Heights: Over the last two years, the Ministry of Labour (MOL) has implemented in stages a mandatory requirement for workers on construction projects to complete a MOL-approved working at heights (WAH) training program before using fall protection equipment. This training requirement is now law for all workers in the sector. Employers must also ensure workers complete approved WAH refresher training within three years of the initial training. For many, this expiry date is fast approaching.

WHMIS-GHS: As of June 1, 2015, employers must train or retrain workers and supervisors to comply with the GHS-related changes to WHMIS regulations. The new Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals (GHS) sets out new rules for classifying and labelling hazardous chemicals.

JHSC Certification: As of March 1, 2016, improved training standards have come into force for certified members of joint health and safety committees (JHSCs). Among other things, from this date forward, employers are required to ensure all trained certified members of a JHSC maintain certification status. To do so, a certified member must complete a MOL-approved Certification Refresher program within three years of completing Certification Part II and every three years thereafter.





Further training obligations include:

- Safe Lockout
- Worker Awareness
- Confined Space Entry
- Supervisor Awareness and Competency
- Mobile Equipment Operator Competency
- Transportation of Dangerous Goods
- Workplace Violence and Harassment.


