Employers have a legal duty to provide their workers with general and job specific instruction and training including:

- Worker Awareness
- JHSC Certification
- WHMIS-GHS
- Working at Heights
- Equipment Operator H&S
- Confined Space Entry
- Lockout
- Transportation of Dangerous Goods
- Workplace Violence and Harassment
