RECERTIFICATION

Gain the expertise and abilities tailored to professions in the medical field, law enforcement, firefighting, or any other vocation that involves a commitment to the well-being and safety of others. Focus on refreshing the important steps to perform a rapid assessment, basic life support, and rapid defibrillation using an automated external defibrillator (AED) for any age group.

As an approved Canadian Red Cross training partner, WHSC courses on basic life support provide professionals with a duty to respond with the necessary confidence and skills to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) plus additional techniques for respiratory distress and obstructed airways. This recertification course meets legislative requirements for provincial/territorial worker safety, insurance boards (WSIB approved) and includes the latest CPR guidelines and training in the use of an AED.
